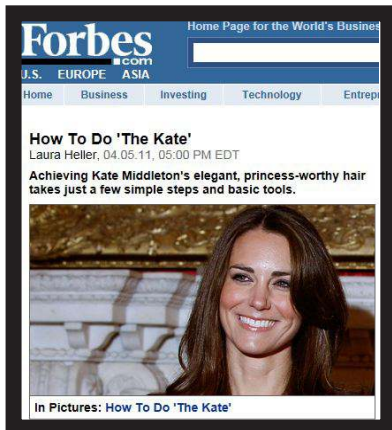

On April 5, 2011, Laura Heller and *Forbes.com* posted a great DIY called How to Do 'The Kate.' Heller concedes that achieving Kate Middleton's elegant, princess-worthy hair takes just a few simple steps and basic tools. The pictorial post features Charles Ifergan, a top Chicago stylist, who says that getting Kate's look is about about "volume."

He achieves the volume by using several round brushes (**handles dangling and all**) and suggest they be left in the hair until the curls have cooled.

Or you can use *Click n Curl* which is much easier, less cumbersome and designed to create volume and elegant flowing curls (without the dangling brush handles).
